- September car sales down 30 pct. from 2018

VW sold 145,152 SUVs year-to-date, up 16 pct. over 2018.



Atlas sales of 6,064 units in September were up 41 pct. over 2018. Year-to-date, Atlas sales of 59,705 are up 39 pct. and have already passed 2018's full year total of 59,677.

Our expanded SUV lineup is helping keep VW owners with the brand. Roughly half (49 pct.) of VW "car" households returning to the brand through the first half of 2019 moved to VW SUVs - up from 43 pct. during the same period in 2018. And 2019 YTD IHS Early Loyalty data indicates that Jetta, GTI, Alltrack, Sportwagen, and Golf households have higher brand loyalty than last year, up 1.8 pct. year-over-year.

Tiguan sales of 7,991 units were up 11 pct. over 2018. Year-to-date Tiguan sales of 84,918 are up 26 pct. over 2018.



"Our SUV sales continue to drive our growth. We expect the start of production on the redesigned Passat to give our sedan sales a boost, and along with the upcoming Cross Sport, set us up for success in 2020."
